- **2.6.1** Our new format for Sporting Clays worked out great. We threw 3000 targets in 2 hours with minimal wait time.
 - Shooters arrive between 8:00 and 8:45 to sign up. Each shooter will be assigned a station.
 - Squads will not exceed 5 shooters.
 - All shooters will be at their station, ready to shoot at 9:00.
 - Shooting will start at 9:00 for all squads.
