No factory ammunition will be available on the club grounds. Practice will be available during the shoot at \$6.00 per round.

All Juniors and Sub-Juniors will receive half price targets.

The club will be open at 8:00 a.m. on shoot days for registration and practice.

**The required ATA fee of \$3.00 and NMSTA fee of \$4.00 will be charged on the first event shot each day.**

**All purses and options are non-compulsory. Ties in options divide the money.**

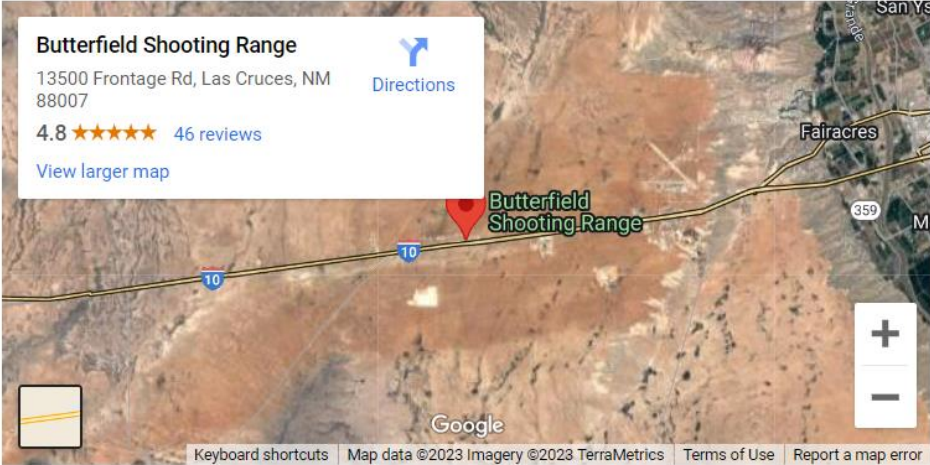

LOCATION

MVSS is located at the Butterfield Shooting Range, which is at the Corralitos exit (Exit 127) on I-10, 12 miles west of Las Cruces.

After you’ve taken the exit, if you were westbound, drive past Bowlin’s Old West Trading Post and turn right at the intersection; if you were eastbound, turn left to drive over the overpass. In either case, now you can follow the asphalt road to the range.

**GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

Classification will be based on official averages and known ability. Shooters with no established average will be placed in not less than Class B in singles and doubles, and not less than the 20 yard line in handicap. Ladies and Sub-Juniors with no established average will be placed in not less than Class C in singles and doubles and not less than the 19 yard line in handicap. Male shooters upon becoming 15 years old will be assigned a handicap of not less than 20 yards.
