**2.1 Financial**. Brock did not have the financial information at the time of the meeting. He emailed the figures to Phillip the next day. "Statement of Financial Position" dated 3/3/23 showing a total bank account in the amount of **\$72,714** and a "Statement of Activity" for 2023 showing a total revenue of \$21,663 and total expenditures of \$22,827 which equals a net operating revenue for 2023 in the amount of **(\$1,164)**.

#### 7.0 Facility Grounds Care

- **7.1** This spring we will have to replace most of our watering hoses and sprinklers. The faucet at Trap #4 is leaking below grade when the faucet is turned on.
- **7.2** Fritz said there are numerous mesquites that need to be eradicated throughout the grounds. Mike said he would contact Boyd to see if he could handle our mesquite problem.

#### 8.0 Discussion

- **8.1** Mining Lead. Brock was going to meet with Lee Abbott to review our options. Brock said he needs our agreement with the City so he can go over it with Lee. Phillip has the agreement and will forward to him after the meeting.
